### **Requirements for Applicant**

1. Only open to members of ISAAC churches
2. Applicant must have attended SOP (in Muar) or a conference (in Muar) within the past 5 years
3. Preferably 21 years & above
4. Minimum education level – High School
5. Proficient in English or the language used at the ISAAC base
6. Minimum of 1 year working experience. No fresh graduates without working experience

### **Application process**

1. The following questions must only be completed by the applicant (not the pastor/parents of applicant)
2. Please answer truthfully.
3. Please answer all questions and explain your answers in detail.
4. Your application form is open for review by the pastor of the ISAAC base you intend to serve at, your pastor and anyone else (parents/guardians) related to this application process.

### **Approval**

1. Your application is subject to a written approval from our headquarters from the desk of Ps Helen David.
2. Please allow 1 month processing time before approval
3. No processing fee is charged
4. Application form must be completed in full to facilitate the process of approval



## **SECTION 2 - QUESTIONS**

### **Serving at an ISAAC Base**

Q1 : How long would you like to serve at an ISAAC base? (minimum 1 month)

Q2 : What dates do you plan for the above stated duration? (ex: 1 Jan 2008 to 31 March 2008)

Q3 : Where do you like to serve?

- state the name of the church & pastor (if you want to serve at a specific base) or state the country (if you are open about serving at any base within that country)

Q4 : Why did you choose that base/country?

Q5: List all your skills and abilities which you can contribute during your time at the base.

Q6: List all areas/departments which you are able and would like to contribute in during your time at the base.

Q7 : What do you seek to establish in your life spiritually while at the base?

Q8 : In what areas of your life (not related to spiritual life) do you desire to learn and develop during your time at the base?

Q9 : Do you require financial support from the base you are serving at?

- If yes, state amount in US Dollars.

- If no, state how you will be supporting yourself (personal savings, parents support, church support etc.)

### **Current church involvement**

Q10 : List all areas of your contribution in your current church (for the past 6 months)

Q11 : What leadership roles do you hold in your church (state the role & duration of time you have served in that role)

### **Personal Assessment**

Q12 : What are your goals and ambition in life?

Q13 : Do you prefer working in teams or as an individual? Why?

Q14 : What particular experiences have you had with teams? (Both positive/negative experiences accepted)

Q15 : What is your most significant strength? (state only 1 area)

Q16 : Please enclose your resume & 1 recommendation letter from a non-family member (either pastor, employer or teacher etc)
