

# THE LOST SHEEP OF THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL

We are standing at the crossroads. God is looking for strategic men who can create specific moves. God is looking for that one man. God is looking for the Select Arrow. The days of heaven on earth are going to happen. What we carry out from this conference will determine the stature in our life. The work will get easier. Nations will turn faster. The cities will be revealed faster.

His strength is made perfect in our weakness. When we are weak, He is strong.

1. The world will not wait for us.  
Learn to spend our time and expand energy for God's Kingdom.
2. 80% to 90% of our wrong decisions are based on what other people feel or think and not offending people which in the end offending ourselves. Make up our mind not to treat people as priority if they treat us as an option.
3. Give your whole attention and spend quality time with those who will miss us more when we are gone.  
Spend time on those who will carry our legacy. Avoid all relationship that will drain us.  
Don't spend time on people who just want to use us.

God is in control of history. History does not control God. God is in charge of this world. Satan does not. God has the final say.

What happened in the upper became an event that happened in every living room in Acts 2. Within a short period of time, the elders said the disciples have filled Jerusalem with the doctrine (Acts 4). Upper room, every living room, classroom, turn the world upside down. Within 2 years the whole of Asia heard the gospel (Acts 17).

They do not have printing press, satellite radio, internet, TV, whatsapp, etc and yet the whole gospel filled the whole of Asia. They had the Holy Spirit and the power of God. Great grace and great power was upon them. God is looking for one strategic man, who would say YES to Him; who is like Samuel or Paul. It is doable in our lifetime.

Before the upper room, there is a rehearsal room. If we can position ourselves properly, what others see as difficult will become doable for us.

*Mat 9:35* And Jesus went about all the cities and the villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of disease and all manner of sickness.

*Mat 9:36* But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion for them, because they were distressed and scattered, as sheep not having a shepherd.

*Mat 9:37* Then saith he unto his disciples, *The harvest indeed is plenteous, but the laborers are few.*

*Mat 9:38* *Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he send forth laborers into his harvest.*

*Mat 10:1* And he called unto him his twelve disciples, and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of disease and all manner of sickness.

*Mat 10:2* Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother;

*Mat 10:3* Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus;

*Mat 10:4* Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him.

*Mat 10:5* These twelve Jesus sent forth, and charged them, saying, *Go not into any way of the Gentiles, and enter not into any city of the Samaritans:*

*Mat 10:6* *but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.*

*Mat 10:7* And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.

*Mat 10:8* Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons: freely ye received, freely give.

*Mat 10:18* *yea and before governors and kings shall ye be brought for my sake, for a testimony to them and to the Gentiles.*

The lost sheep could be you. They are sheep, they are not goats. They are lost but they are in the house.

There are many disciples in the nation but something is disconnecting them from becoming the disciples of the nation. We may be building the church but we leave the discipling into His hands. That's what most of us have been doing. We have hijacked the church by literally declaring, "I will build my church."

Are we making disciples of the nation or disciples in the nation? We are very passionate like Apollos with what we know but limited with our approach. We are passionate and yet we are

limited. We are not producing the kind of results God wants us to produce. We may be living right, do not sin, etc but if we talk politics, we will be saying love not the world and etc.

In every area we vacant, Satan occupies. We must learn how to infiltrate and influence and fill the culture of the world with the culture of Christ.

This is the opportunity they had to go into the world. This is the disciple's rehearsal room.

We are the lost sheep who has come to GLS year after year but never reproduce the same GLS in the different nations.

Who are we listening to? If we listen to one, we offends the other. Listen to the word of God and crisis will end. We have the same access to God as in Papa or Dr. Tunde.

Jesus called the twelve disciples to Himself. These are the twelve that can be called to Himself. The next day, from disciples they became apostles. Jesus gave them power over unclean spirits. The unclean spirits influence cultures.

We cannot afford to be the lost sheep in the house. We have to make disciples OF the nation. The gospel of the Kingdom must be preached to the nations and the end will come.

If we are not on top of any of the mountain, we are lost in the house. Where is the location of the call when Jesus called the disciples upon Himself.

*Mar 3:13 And He went up on the mountain and **summoned those whom He Himself wanted**, and they came to Him.*

If we want to have an impacting ministry, we better open our heart to God and disciple people.

*Joh 2:11 This beginning of His signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.*

*Joh 2:12 After this He went down to Capernaum, **He and His mother and His brothers and His disciples**; and they stayed there a few days.*

That is the entourage of Jesus when He entered Capernaum. His mother and brothers are not His disciples.

*Mar 3:13 And He went up on the mountain and summoned those whom He Himself wanted, and they came to Him.*

*Mar 3:14 And He appointed twelve, so that they would be with Him and that He could send them out to preach,*  
*Mar 3:15 and to have authority to cast out the demons.*

*Mar 3:16 And He appointed the twelve: Simon (to whom He gave the name Peter),*

*Mar 3:17 and James, the son of Zebedee, and John the brother of James (to them He gave the name Boanerges, which means, "Sons of Thunder");*

*Mar 3:18 and Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Zealot;*

*Mar 3:19 and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Him.*

*Mar 3:20 And He came home, and the crowd gathered again, to such an extent that they could not even eat a meal.*

*Mar 3:21 When His own people heard of this, they went out to take custody of Him; for they were saying, "He has lost His senses."*

Are we sent?

*Mar 3:31 Then His mother and His brothers arrived, and standing outside they sent word to Him and called Him.*

*Mar 3:32 A crowd was sitting around Him, and they said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are outside looking for You."*

*Mar 3:33 Answering them, He said, "Who are My mother and My brothers?"*

*Mar 3:34 Looking about at those who were sitting around Him, He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers!*

*Mar 3:35 "For whoever does the will of God, he is My brother and sister and mother."*

He just called on those who He Himself wanted.

*Mar 6:7 And He summoned the twelve and began to send them out in pairs, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits;*

*Mat 10:2 Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; and James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother;*

*Mat 10:3 Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus;*

*Mat 10:4 Simon the Zealot, and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed Him.*

We need strategic men and we need to be accurately positioned.

*Act 9:19 and he took food and was strengthened. Now for several days he was with the disciples who were at Damascus,*

*Act 9:20 and immediately he began to proclaim Jesus in the synagogues, saying, "He is the Son of God."*

*Act 9:21 All those hearing him continued to be amazed, and were saying, "Is this not he who in Jerusalem destroyed those who called on this name, and who had come here for the purpose of bringing them bound before the chief priests?"*

*Act 9:27* But Barnabas took hold of him and brought him to the apostles and described to them how he had seen the Lord on the road, and that He had talked to him, and how at Damascus he had spoken out boldly in the name of Jesus.

*Act 9:28* And he was with them, moving about freely in Jerusalem, speaking out boldly in the name of the Lord.

*Act 9:29* And he was talking and arguing with the Hellenistic Jews; but they were attempting to put him to death.

*Act 9:30* But when the brethren learned of it, they brought him down to Caesarea and sent him away to Tarsus.

*Act 9:31* So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it continued to increase.

*Joh 13:2* During supper, the devil having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon, to betray Him,

There are 3 Simons in the disciples; Simon Peter, Simon the zealot and Judas the son of Simon. The 2 Simons are a team.

If we are not sent, we will become food for the devil. That's why we must be in a place where we can be trained and increase in stature so that we can become an influence.

There must be people boundary. Do not go into the ways of Gentiles.

*Mat 4:12* Now when Jesus heard that John had been taken into custody, He withdrew into Galilee;

*Mat 4:13* and leaving Nazareth, He came and settled in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali.

*Mat 4:14* This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet:

*Mat 4:15* "THE LAND OF ZEBULUN AND THE LAND OF NAPHTALI, BY THE WAY OF THE SEA, BEYOND THE JORDAN, GALILEE OF THE GENTILES--

*Mat 4:16* "THE PEOPLE WHO WERE SITTING IN DARKNESS SAW A GREAT LIGHT, AND THOSE WHO WERE SITTING IN THE LAND AND SHADOW OF DEATH, UPON THEM A LIGHT DAWNED."

*Mat 9:35* Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

*Mat 9:36* Seeing the people, He felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and dispirited like sheep without a shepherd.

When the sheep has no shepherd, they are lost. No one gave them the sense of direction and what the Spirit is saying. What happen to the shepherd?

*Jer 50:6* "My people have become lost sheep; Their shepherds have led them astray. **They have made them turn aside on the mountains; They have gone along from mountain to hill And have forgotten their resting place.**

*Jer 50:7* "All who came upon them have devoured them; And their adversaries have said, 'We are not guilty, Inasmuch as they have sinned against the LORD who is the habitation of righteousness, Even the LORD, the hope of their fathers.'

What the shepherds have taught the people are winning souls but never showed them their mountain. These preachers turn the people away from the mountains.

**Eze 34:1** *Then the word of the LORD came to me saying,*

**Eze 34:2** *"Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel. Prophesy and say to those shepherds, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, 'Woe, shepherds of Israel who have been feeding themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flock?'*

**Eze 34:11** *For thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out.*

**Eze 34:12** *"As a shepherd cares for his herd in the day when he is among his scattered sheep, so I will care for My sheep and will deliver them from all the places to which they were scattered on a cloudy and gloomy day.*

**Eze 34:13** *"I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries and bring them to their own land; and I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the streams, and in all the inhabited places of the land.*

**Eze 34:14** *"I will feed them in a good pasture, and their grazing ground will be on the mountain heights of Israel. There they will lie down on good grazing ground and feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Israel.*

Many of us must know where our mountain is. If we don't know what our mountain is, then we are a lost sheep.

**Rev 17:1** *Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, "Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters,*

**Rev 17:2** *with whom the kings of the earth committed acts of immorality, and those who dwell on the earth were made drunk with the wine of her immorality."*

**Rev 17:3** *And he carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness; and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast, full of blasphemous names, having seven heads and ten horns.*

The only person that can kick the woman out of her seat is you and I. The mountains are ready for the taking but the people who are suppose to take the mountain is lost in the house.
