

FROM THE CROSS TO THE THRONE

God will not support anything He has not begun. If He sanctions something He will carry us through all the way.

If we deal well with sin, then Satan will have nothing in us. Sickness and curses will never come. All kinds of superstitious will never happen to us. God sets us free by sending His Son to us. Remember why He died on the cross of Calvary. Jesus had to come into the world, partake the same nature like us.

Heb 2:14 *Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,*
Heb 2:15 *and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.*

Jesus has to become flesh and blood just like us and come into the world. We have to be clear in our heart so that when we deal with sin, sickness, satanic spirits and all kinds of situations the enemy sent against us. God will give us grace to govern and the power to prevail.

Jesus had to go through all types of temptation so that he can break them and bring life. Jesus took that power of death away. Death cannot come unless God allows it.

Jas 1:12 *Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.*

Jas 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone.

Jas 1:14 But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust.

Jas 1:15 Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death.

Jas 1:16 Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren.

If we hear what the Holy Spirit is saying, we can overcome.

We must persevere, patient, strong and push until we win. It is not the time to give up or give in. We cannot come to Mt Zion and become part of the general assembly if we do not have the foundation. We cannot be part of the church if our sins are not forgiven. Christ must live in our life and the Holy Spirit must fully take over and be part of the new covenant. All the foundation is from down upwards. We must understand our foundation.

The only one that can be disobedient and not afraid of the devil is us. We can look into the face of the devil and warn him that he cannot touch our lives. Fight until we win. Don't let go in mid air.

Each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. They are carried away in their mind. There are so many philosophies that can trip us and entice us in our own lust. There is something inside us that make us do wrong. Lust will bring sin and when sin is accomplished death comes.

When we pray for cancer, we pray for cancer cells to die. Sin is the same. It is a mindset not based on truth.

Don't change these things and get carried away and enticed by our own lust. When we eat the food or fruit, it goes to the stomach and does not go to the brain. What we eat does not defile us. At most we just need to go to the toilet. It is our mind and our thinking that can defile us.

God is the only person that will not laugh at us when we ask Him for answers. We must ask in faith without doubting.

Isa 14:12 "How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations!

Isa 14:13 **"But you said in your heart,** 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north.

Isa 14:14 'I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.'

Isa 14:15 "Nevertheless you will be thrust down to Sheol, To the recesses of the pit.

Isa 14:16 "Those who see you will gaze at you, They will ponder over you, saying, 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, Who shook kingdoms,

How did Lucifer fall? Lucifer fell because he said in his heart. The women with the issue of blood also said to herself. That's why it is dangerous to keep speaking the negatives because we will become negative. One reason God will leave us is when we make ourselves like Him. 2. The pleasure of sin

It promised to offer hidden joy and shameful happiness. We take bribery money and take home. It's like a scratch that we keep scratching and didn't realize that the scratch has now become a scar or a hole.

3. The predicament / chaos of sin

It will produce guilt and curse and gives us opportunity to lie. When sin hits us, we know that we are telling a lie but we can't stop it. We will get confused thought patterns.

4. The penalty of sin

The punishment and judgment and death will come. Whatever we hide with evil and marinate our good things with evil, the whole thing will be destroyed. There is a price to pay with sin.

5. The power of sin

Sin can hold our whole life in a ransom and the law of sin and death to operate. We cannot stop it except we live in God's ways. God's way will shut down the life of the flesh. If we suspect something is wrong in our life, shut it down immediately. Go to the scriptures and set ourselves free. Sin is a nature that feeds on the flesh. The flesh is thinking outside of God's ways no matter how smart it is. The flesh will make think we are like God. We must always go back to where we started.
